



Junior Racing Development Dominates Formula Vee Qualifying at Bathurst 12 Hour

Junior Racing Development has dominated qualifying at the Bathurst 12 Hour support event. With qualifying held this morning, JRD driver Ryan Simpson set a pole position time well below the current lap record and a whopping 1.1 seconds ahead of second place.

In his first qualifying session in the FORCE TOOLS / Parramatta Smash Repairs Sabre 02 and his first back in Formula Vee for some time, Ryan was in a class of his own. Team mate James Simpson lost track position early and had to fight his way into fifth place with a late charge on his fifth lap for the session.

"The Sabre 02 is really good and I am very impressed with its handling and responsiveness to change" said a very pleased (Ryan) Simpson. "We still have a few little things we want to try to get a little more speed from the car but overall that was a good qualifying and now I am looking forward to this afternoon's first race".

James Simpson was also pleased with the set up and pace of his Sabre 02. *"We lost our position on track early due to a fouling plug and once I had cleared it I was not with the group I needed to be with to put in my best times. I am not unhappy though as the data shows that I am much closer to Ryan than the times reflect so I will be competitive come race time".*

The teams pole position means that we have had the car on P1 in all but one of the events entered since the launch of the Sabre 02 back in May last year.
